



Hockey Director:

Jordan French-

Originally from Texas, Jordan played junior hockey in the NAHL prior to transitioning into full time coaching. He spent 7 years building the Dallas Stars Elite program as the Tier I Skills Coach and Head Coach prior to relocating to Nashville to take over as the Tier I & II Hockey Director and Head Coach for the Nashville Jr. Predators organization. He has since started his own elite training and development company, Jordan French Hockey. providing professional skills coaching for current NHL, college, major junior, and youth hockey players. With 7 players drafted in the NHL, over 20 NCAA Division I players, and multiple Tier I & II National qualifying teams, it is no wonder that Jordan has become one of the most sought-after skill and development coaches nationally as well as locally. This season Jordan will be returning for his 3rd season as Hockey Director for the Music City Marauders.









The Ice Barn

Located near Leipers Fork, The Ice Barn is a private facility containing one sheet of ice. It has two locker rooms and serves as the primary location for Music City Marauders practices.




Ford Ice Center Clarksville

Set to open in 2023, Ford Ice Center - Clarksville is a full-size, regulation sheet of ice attached to F&M Bank Arena in downtown Clarksville. The facility will have four locker rooms, skate rental, and seating capacity for 300 spectators.

Gary Force Acura Ice Arena

Gary Force Acura Ice Arena opened in 2021 in Nolensville, TN. The facility has one full-size, regulation sheet of ice along with locker rooms.





Boys Tier II

We are excited to be offering additional age divisions for the 2023-2024 hockey season. All teams will play a highly competitive schedule consisting of 8-12 weekends against Tier I & II competition. Tournaments and showcases will be mixed in with local and travel friendly games. All practices will be high intensity sessions that focus on accurate skill demonstration along with clear and concise teaching and explanation. Teams will have access to their own practice ice (no shared ice) and practices will begin in August and the season will end in March.



Mite Development Program
